✓ SUB.H.B. 459 (Mrs. Kitchel) AN ACT AMENDING AN ACT CONCERNING THE BOARD OF HEALTH OF THE TOWN OF GREENWICH.

WM.S.HIRSCHBERG: The present law under which our municipal hospital operates provides that three members of the Board of Estimate and Taxation shall be members of the board or committee that operates the municipal hospital. It has been thought advisable in Greenwich to divorce from the Board of Estimate anything that has to do with matters other than finance. This puts us in the nature of a spending body and puts us in a position of passing on our own appropriations. I don't know of any opposition to this bill.

MR.ALLYN: Have these proposed changes been made public ?

MR.HIRSCHBERG: Yes sir.

SEN.CLAFFEY: Do you admit people to this hospital who are able to pay ?

JUDGE HIRSCHBERG: Yes. This municipal hospital is owned and operated by the town, but they do take paid cases.

SEN.CLAFFEY: You don't take patients who pay except these the other hospitals won't provide for ?

MR.HIRSCHBERG: That is right.
