Senate Bill No. 654 (Leipner) AN ACT AMENDING THE PLANNING ENABLING LAW.

Mr. Arthur Barrows, Waterford: The 1947 revision of the enabling act left out the old provisions in the planning act which would provide for the assessment of benefits and damages. Today if a community wishes to widen and straighten a street, it can only do so under eminent domain. This has hamstrung existing planning agencies. We believe it should be restored. The Federation is in favor of this bill.

Pierce J. Gerety, Town Counsel, Fairfield: In favor of this bill; in connection with the Connecticut Federation of planning and Zoning Agencies, many of the towns have wanted to introduce special legislation to restore these powers.

Chairman Dichter: Anyone Else?

Mr. Ira Hicks: On H. B. 1159, the tax department wished me to advise you that it has no objection to this bill.
