SENATOR HEALEY: Mr. President, this bill repeals sec. 7275 and has to do with foreclosures of chattel mortgages. It is a very simple one and it allows, adds the words 'or any judge thereof', him to order the possession by chattel mortgagee of the chattel involved, if the judge feels it is necessary. It is a bill which will be helpful when courts are not in session.

THE CLERK: Cal. 258, file 275, SB 227 an act concerning dissolution of mechanic's lien by substitution of bond.

(Upon motion of Senator Longo of the 19th district for acceptance of the committee's favorable report and passage of the bill, a voice vote was taken and the president declared the report accepted and the bill passed)

SENATOR LONGO: Mr. President, this bill repeals sec. 7221 of the general statutes to enable a party foreclosing a mechanics lien to amend his claim where a bond has been filed so as to recover on such bond.

THE CLERK: Cal. 259, file 273 SB 385 an act concerning larceny (Upon motion of Senator Longo of the 19th for acceptance of the committee's favorable report and passage of the bill, a voice vote was taken and the president declared the bill passed)

SENATOR LONGO: I have an amendment. Will the Clerk please read the amendment.
