THE CHAIR:

Question is on passage of this bill. Will you remark.

SENATOR EDDY:

This is a matter that concerns the Town of Wethersfield. Sometime ago Wethersfield constructed a sidewalk in the ordinary manner along the street. Along that street was part of state property. When the time came to build all abutting land owners paid up to the customary practice except it was discovered that the state was unable to do it under the laws.

So this legislation is merely in here to enable the state to reimburse the Town of Wethersfield for monies spent on a sidewalk.

Mr. Speaker, this bill would change the name or title of
the hospital cost analyst of the hospital cost commission to
executive director of that commission. Its sole purpose is to
change the title and it has no other purpose. There is no change
in grade, there is no change in salary. The reason for this is
that the present hospital cost analyst is, in fact, the highest
official of the hospital cost commission. He is involved with
planning, appearances at hearings, both on a state and federal
level, he appears in court and he recommends policy decision to
the hospital cost commission. Under the circumstances it is
felt that his title should be changed to executive director of
that commission and such a change has, in fact, been approved by
the hospital cost commission.
