THE CLERK:

Page 5 of the Calendar, at the top of the page, Calendar No. 445, H.B. No. 5341, An Act Concerning the Form of Bills Amending the General Amendments to the Constitution.

MR. PRETE (114th):

Mr. Speaker, I move acceptance of the Joint Committee's favorable report and passage of the bill.

THE SPEAKER:

Question is on acceptance and passage. Will you remark?

MR. PRETE (114th):

Mr. Speaker, the Clerk has an amendment.

THE SPEAKER:

Would the Clerk call House Amendment Schedule "A", Calendar No. 445, H.B. No. 5341, in your file File No. 374.

The amendment to which I am referring offers changes in the bill in lines 4 and 18 at the same time.

THE CLERK:

House Amendment Schedule "A" offered by Mr. Prete of the 114th.

In line 4, after the word "statute, insert the following: ", each special act amending any special act,".

In line 18, after the word "bills" insert the following: ",special acts".

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MR. PRETE (114th):

Mr. Speaker, the amendment includes special acts under the purvue of the bill. It's an entirely technical amendment and I move its adoption.

THE SPEAKER:

The question is on adoption of House Amendment Schedule "A". Will you remark further? If not, all those in favor indicate by saying aye. Those opposed? The amendment's ruled technical. We may proceed with the bill as amended.

MR. PRETE (114th):

Mr. Speaker, the bill is a technical bill and allows changes in the form of our bills as they pass through the IBM machine and the Legislative Commissioner's Office and the Clerk's Office. It's a housekeeping bill, a worthwhile one, and I urge its passage, as amended by House Amendment Schedule "A".
