DAVID J. SULLIVAN, JR.:

Mr. Speaker, this Amendment clarifies the procedure to be used in the circumstances when a Probate Judge has not made the proper payments during the course of a year. If, for instance, there has been a...he has been ill and has been unable to conduct the office to the point where he's...his income is what it should be, this now provides for a procedure to allow for hardships in this case and to allow a man to continue to run for the office in the next year which he would be eligible. I move acceptance of Senate Amendment "A".

MR. SPEAKER:

Question's on acceptance of Senate Amendment Schedule "A". Will you remark further. If not, the question's on acceptance of Senate Amendment "A". All those in favor will indicate by saying "aye". Opposed. The Amendment is adopted.

DAVID J. SULLIVAN, JR.:

Mr. Speaker, the purpose of the entire Bill as amended is simply to provide for the situation that we find has occurred when new Probate Judges take office. Under the existing statutes they must estimate and begin to make their payments within...by January 31st of the first year in which they take office. We have found that this is a hardship on the new Judges, and under this particular piece of legislation they will be able to estimate their earnings and then change them as they appear during

the course of the year. It's a good Bill, and I think it should pass.

MR. SPEAKER:

Will you remark further on the Bill as amended. If not, the question's on acceptance of the Joint Committee's favorable report and passage of the Bill as amended by Senate Amendment Schedule "A", in concurrence. All those in favor will indicate by saying "aye". Opposed. The Bill is passed.
