SENATOR SMITH:

Mr. President, this amends section (31-234) of the '69 supplement of our Statutes. Individuals who are eligible to receive unemployment compensation benefits and who acquire additional dependents during a benefit year may receive a dependency allowance for that newly acquired dependent in the next following calendar week. The purpose of this bill provides for the payment of a dependency allowance for claimants who acquire new dependents during the benefit year of receiving unemployment benefits. I move for passage.
