THE CHAIR:

Senator Pac.

SENATOR PAC:

Mr. President, I move acceptance of the joint committee's
favorable report and passage of the bill.

THE CHAIR:

Will you remark?

SENATOR PAC:

The Clerk has an amendment. And in lieu of the reading of
the amendment. I would explain it to the members of the circle.

THE CHAIR:

You have just moved that the reading of the amendment be
waived? And so ordered there being no objection.

SENATOR PAC:

I move adoption of the amendment. This amendment would
provide the parking authority of a municipality to issue general
obligation bonds. That would be amortized equally as the

principal and interest over the life time of the bond. Currently all general obligation bond, when they are issued they are amortized equally after the principal. And the interest is generally paid heavily during the early years of the bond. This is kind of a front loading situation. Now when a community wishes to lease the parking facilities so forth. And this puts an extraordinary burden on facilities that, such as hospitals that do want to lease these garages. So this is the purpose of this amendment.

THE CHAIR:

Will you remark further? On the amendment. If not all those in favor of the amendment signify by saying aye. AYE? Opposed nay? The ayes have it. The amendment is passed. Ruled technical. You may proceed.

SENATOR PAC:

Mr. President, I move passage of the bill as amended by Senate Amendment Sch. A.

THE CHAIR:

Will you remark further?

SENATOR PAC:

The bill itself would permit the parking authorities of any town who have had the authority previously to construct a parking facility. Now they would be able to expand it. They haven't had this previous authority.

THE CHAIR:

Will you remark further on the bill as amended? If not all those in favor of passage of the bill as amended signify by saying aye. AYE. Opposed nay? The ayes have it. The bill is passed. As amended.
