Yes. This bill would make a number of technical changes to the Sections of the General Statutes amended by Public Act 76-436. An Act Transferring all Trial Jurisdiction to the Superior Court.

This bill would also establish a rule by which amendments made by Public Act 76-436 and enactments of the current session can be integrated. The bill would in cases where the same section of the statute was amended by Public Act 76-436 and by a Public Act of the current session expressly preserve the effectiveness of each amendment except in the case of an irreconcilable conflict. In that case only the act of the current session would be effective.
