SEN. LOONEY:

Yes, thank you, Mr. President. Move for suspension to take up the single item on Senate Agenda No. 6, Substitute for House Bill 5820.

THE CHAIR:

Without objection, please proceed.

SEN. LOONEY:

Yes, thank you, Mr. President. Move that this item be marked Go. It is our technical revisor's bill.

THE CHAIR:

Mr. Clerk.

THE CLERK:

Calling from Senate Agenda No. 6, Substitute for House Bill 5820, An Act Concerning the Revisor's Technical Corrections to the General Statutes and the 2006 Supplement to the General Statutes (As amended by House Amendment Schedule "A"), Favorable Report of the Committee on Judiciary.

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THE CHAIR:

Senator McDonald.

SEN. MCDONALD:

Thank you, Mr. President. Mr. President, I move acceptance of the Joint Committee's Favorable Report and passage of the bill in concurrence with the House.

THE CHAIR:

On acceptance and passage, Senator McDonald.

SEN. MCDONALD:

Thank you, Mr. President. As the Majority Leader indicated, this is our technical revisor's bill. It announces some 200 pages of technical revisions as assembled by the Legislative Commissioner's Office, and I urge passage.

REP. SPALLONE: (36th)

Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Mr. Speaker, I move acceptance of the Joint Committee's Favorable Report and passage of the Bill.

SPEAKER AMANN:

The question is on acceptance of the Joint Committee's Favorable Report and passage of the Bill. Will you remark, Sir?

REP. SPALLONE: (36th)

Mr. Speaker, this is our annual act concerning revisor's technical corrections to the General Statutes. It has corrections concerning grammar, style and usage within the General Statutes.

It also contains some technical corrections to matters that have been approved by the General Assembly in the last few days that contain drafting errors and other problems.

CLERK:

LCO Number 5795, House "A", offered by
Representative Lawlor.

SPEAKER AMANN:

Representative Spallone, do you care to remark,
Sir?

REP. SPALLONE: (36th)

Thank you, Mr. Speaker. House "A" makes
additional technical changes and corrections, and also
contains the matters I referred to earlier correcting
some bills that have been passed by this Assembly
during the Session. I move adoption.

SPEAKER AMANN:
