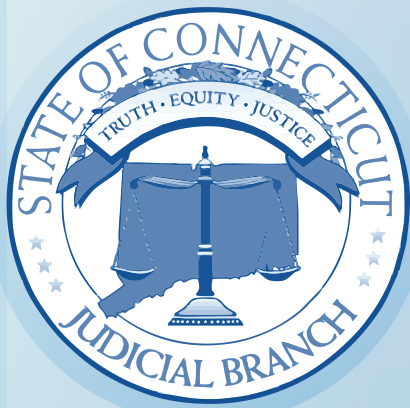

** The School of Law recommends that, for events in Starr Hall, the **best GPS address is:**

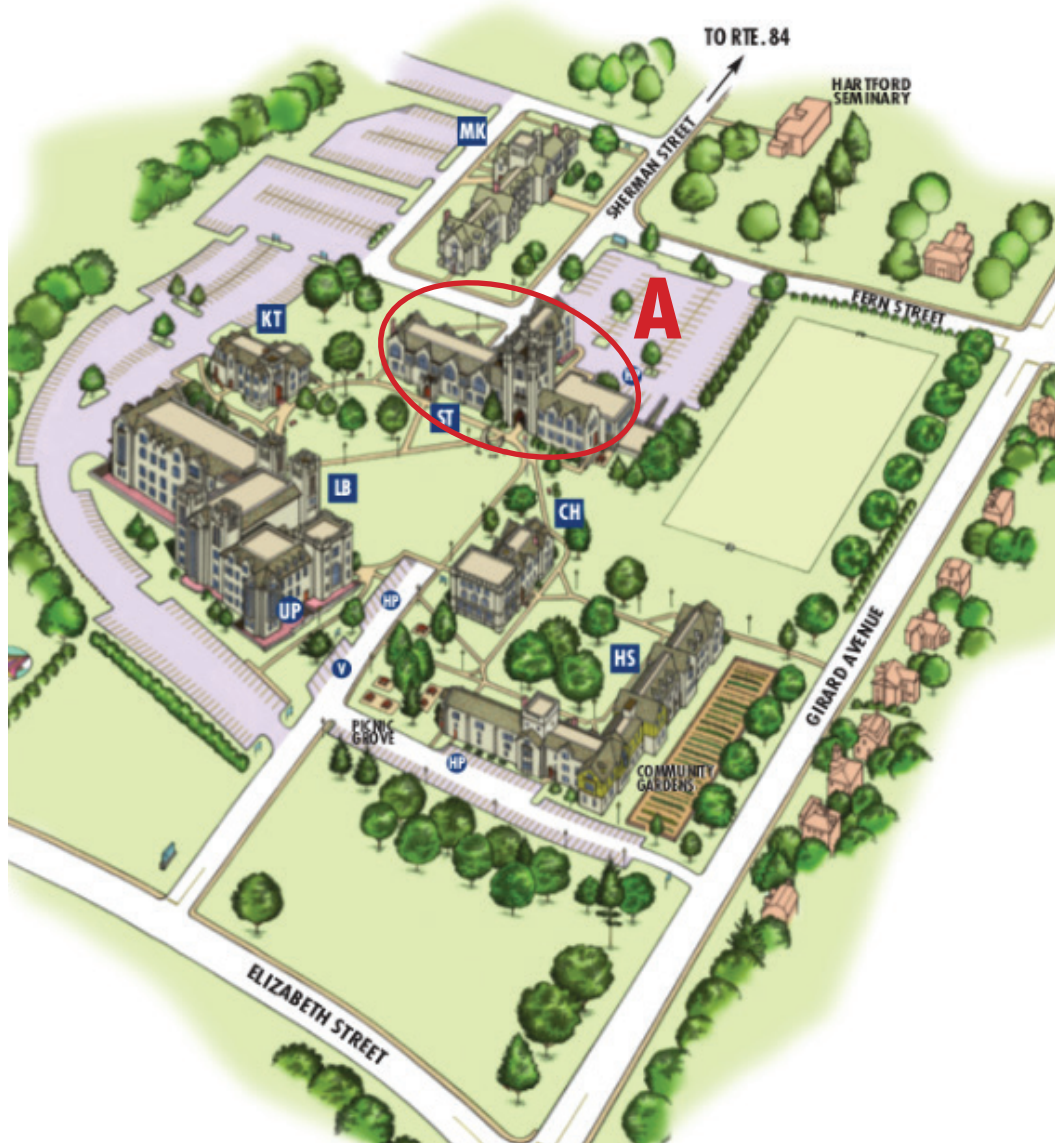

- Take Exit 46
- Turn right onto Sisson Avenue
- Continue straight through the light at Farmington Avenue, onto Sherman Street
- The Starr Hall parking lot is directly ahead



Parking Information / Accessibility

- Parking is available in Lot "A" for Starr Hall, indicated by a red "A" above
- Lot "A" has handicapped parking available
- Starr Hall is accessible, by ramp, from Lot "A"
