Introduction

The earliest Secretary for the government on record is John Steel who kept the earliest minutes of the **General Court**. He held the position from approximately the first meeting in April 1636 until the election of **Edward Hopkins** on April 11, 1639. Since then, it has proven to be one of the more important positions in colonial and state government. It serves as the principal record office for the State preserving vital information on corporations, commercial lending, elections, legislation and other relevant areas. The Secretary also serves as **Commissioner of Elections**, administers the state's notary public laws, publishes the **State Register and Manual**; licenses all **certified public accountants**, and fulfills other statutory responsibilities assigned to it by the General Assembly.

Currently, the Secretary's office consists of **Management and Support Services**, **Commercial Recording Division**, **Legislation and Elections Administration Division** and the **State Board of Accountancy**. The **Division of Management and Support Services** includes the Secretary and the **Capitol office staff**, the **Deputy Secretary of the State** and various support functions. The **Commercial Recording Division** includes the **Corporation Unit**, which **files** and maintains statutorily required records involving the **creation or alteration** of corporations, foundations, and other business entities. The **Uniform Commercial Code (UCC) Unit** **handles** transaction regarding financial statements for personal property affected by liens and other security interest.

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The **Legislation and Elections Administration Division** **administers** state and federal laws pertaining to elections, primaries, voting rights and campaign finances. **This office** also assists the Secretary of the State in training local election officials, town clerks and registrars of **voters**.

The division keeps the official records of all acts, orders, **grants**, and resolutions of the General Assembly and all state departments and agencies. It transmits all legislative acts to the Governor for his action and returns vetoed bills and messages to the General Assembly. It notifies legislators of **special** and veto sessions, prints and distributes copies of all acts effective from passage, prepares plain and **certified copies** of legislation, resolutions, and regulations. The division administers all laws regarding **notary publics**. It also validates elections or appointments of notaries public, judges, town clerks, and other state and **municipal offices**.

The **Legislation and Elections Administration Division** also **compiles**, publishes, and distributes materials concerning state history and government including the annual **Connecticut State Register and Manual**.

The **Records Management Unit** provides record keeping services to the Secretary's office.

The **Board of Accountancy** consists of six gubernatorial appointments. Four are licensed professional accountants and two are public members. The board is **responsible** to ensure that the highest standards of integrity and professionalism are maintained by the state's certified public accountants and licensed public accounts. The board oversees all aspects of the **Certified Public Account (CPA) exam**.

Sec. 3-77 of the Connecticut General Statutes appoints the Secretary of the State as keeper of "all the public records and documents and record all acts, orders, grants and resolution of the general assembly." This provision also authorizes the secretary to "turn over any such records, documents or papers to the state library". As a result, the Library has within its custody many valuable older state records. Most of these records reside in the record groups for their originating body (i.e. the Colony of Connecticut (RG 1), the General Assembly (RG 2), the Judicial Department (RG 3), etc.
